

## **Expectations for You You Should Know About the Following Things at Camp**

### **Lineup**

- There will be a leadership lineup every **Monday**. You will go to this lineup instead of your bunk's lineup.
- After leadership lineup you will go back to your bunkhouse; if you have CITs/LITs in the morning you still go back to your bunkhouse first.

### **Morning Swim**

- If you have chosen to be a helper during morning swim you will participate in the Mini Workshop.
- Come prepared (swim shoes and bathing suits)
- Listen to WSI by going in the pool when asked
- Do not be a distraction; do your best to help. Ask questions if you are not sure of how you can help.
- If you have chosen to do the alternate activity instead of helping at the pool, you must be present at the activity. **No exceptions! You are either at the pool or at the alternate activity.**

### **Bunkhouse**

- You will be asked to assist counselors by helping campers put on sunscreen and watching campers who are waiting outside and are ready for the next activity. This is a great time to get to know your campers! Talk to them, ask them questions about themselves.

### **Activities**

- Have fun, but be responsible as well
  - Assist in each activity; if in doubt, ask your SC what you can do.
  - Remember that you are older than your campers; you are bigger and stronger.

### **Clubs**

- If you are with a younger bunk you may be asked to walk and pick up your campers from his/her club.

### **Lunch**

- When going to get food, make sure you take your red tray.
- You cannot serve hot food to your campers.

- But you can...
  - Help pour and refill drinks
  - Assist at the salad bar

### **Olympics**

- For CITs only...
  - Ambassadors will be chosen to be the symbolic representatives for the 3 countries chosen to compete in the SSDC Summer Olympics.

### **Mr./Ms. SSDC**

- Can be won by CITs and LITs
- You will be asked to complete tasks and will be evaluated for spirit, kindness, responsibility, and a love for camp. The King and Queen will have their picture displayed on the camp website homepage for the whole year.

### **Jr. General**

- For LITs only
- Follow above expectations
- Show Camp Spirit everyday, especially on Spirit Day
- Demonstrate leadership within your bunk and during CIT/LIT periods.
- Can win both Mr./Ms. SSDC and be chosen as a Jr. General!

In addition to understanding the following: LITs and CITs Co-Ordinate a Camp-Wide food collection for needy Bucks County Families during Friendship Week (Color Games Week). This selfless activity also earns points for their team.

Finally, camp hosts a group of children and young adults with intellectual disabilities from the Hopes and Dreams Foundation. You will partner with fellow LITs and CITs along with individuals from this group to give them a day of fun and special bonding. This is always a rewarding day for everyone.
